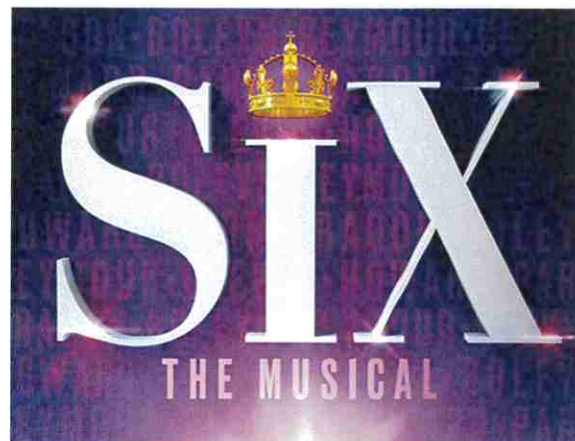

The competition is open to aspiring bakers and cake decorators from EYFS to KS2.

### Theme

- Step into a world of imagination and creativity with our Cake Decorating Competition!
- This year's theme, "A Storybook Spectacle," invites contestants to design cupcakes inspired by your favourite books author, literary character, or story theme.
- Whether it's a classic novel, a fairy tale, or a modern bestseller, the cakes should tell a story through creative design and decoration.

### Submissions

- Students will be asked to decorate (not bake) 3 cupcakes, following the theme outlined above.
- We will run a Castlefields competition on **Monday 28th April**. Three winners from Castlefields will compete at Church Stretton School in the final.
- Please can you bring 3 plain fairy cakes and any decorations required with you on **Monday 28th April** and the children will decorate the cakes in their storybook design in a 'Bake off style' challenge.
- The final competition will be hosted at **Church Stretton School** for the 21 top decorators on **Friday 23rd May** @ 1.15pm. 3 plain cakes will be provided by CSS for each finalist.

### Judging

- Visual Impact – Use of colours, textures, and overall presentation.
- Relevance to Theme – Clear connection to literature.
- Creativity & Originality – How well the cake captures the essence of the book.
