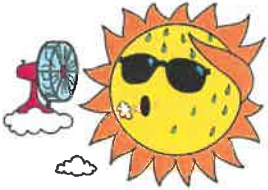

### **Extreme Weather**

As you will be aware, we are under a red weather warning for extreme heat on Monday and Tuesday. We would like all children to:



**Bring a sun hat with a wide brim or a cap**

**Wear their school uniform or school PE kit (whichever is best for your child)**

**Wear sun cream of at least SPF 15**

**Bring a labelled water bottle**

**Bring a cloth/flannel (in a bag) that they can soak to keep cool**

We will limit the amount of time that they will spend outdoors as we only have limited shade, and will keep the classrooms as well ventilated as possible. We will also be refilling water bottles to ensure children are hydrated.

If your child has a medical condition or really struggles with extreme heat, you are welcome to keep them at home on Monday and/or Tuesday. Please contact the absence line in the usual way. If your child is in school but we feel they are showing signs of struggling we will, of course, call and ask you to collect them.

### **Medication**

All children will bring home medication that is kept in school on Tuesday. Over the summer holiday, please check the expiry date and bring it back to school when we return in September.
