Outdoor, Active Learning

We feel, as a school, that a real positive to come out of Covid (and we know that there aren't many) is the fact that we have used the school grounds more.

We are proud to be an active school and know our children benefit from working outdoors to relate their learning to the wider world. As we get closer to winter it is really important that your child has the right clothing in order for them to enjoy play-times, lunchtimes and woodlands school happily and safely. If you can help them to be prepared (coats on rainy days, welly boots or trainers if the ground is likely to be muddy, extra pairs of socks if they get cold feet) they will be far happier outside and enjoy learning experiences more.

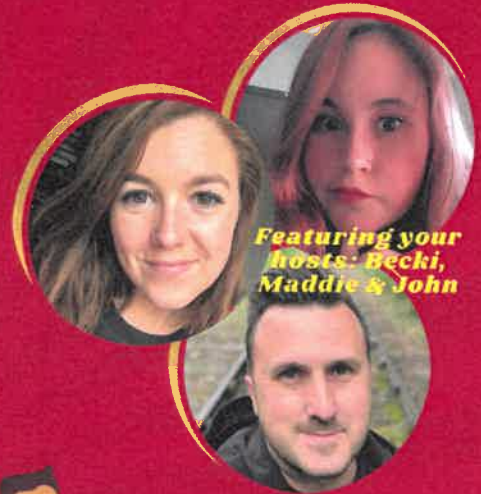
